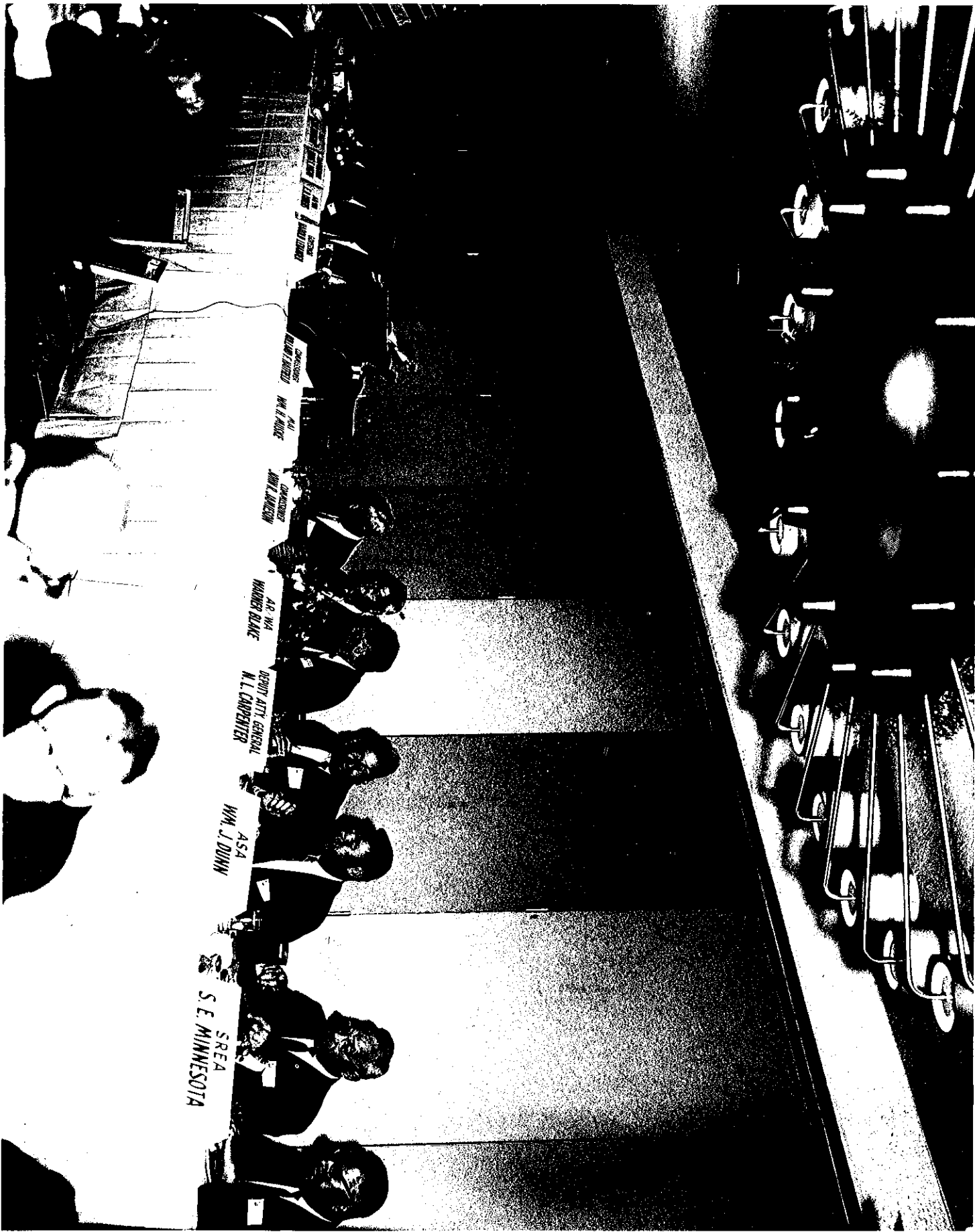
DOUTHITT LAUDED

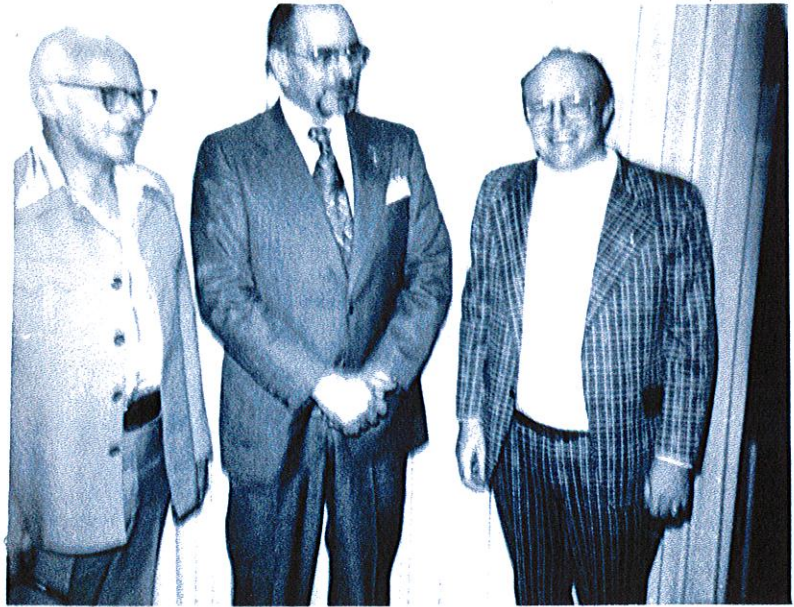

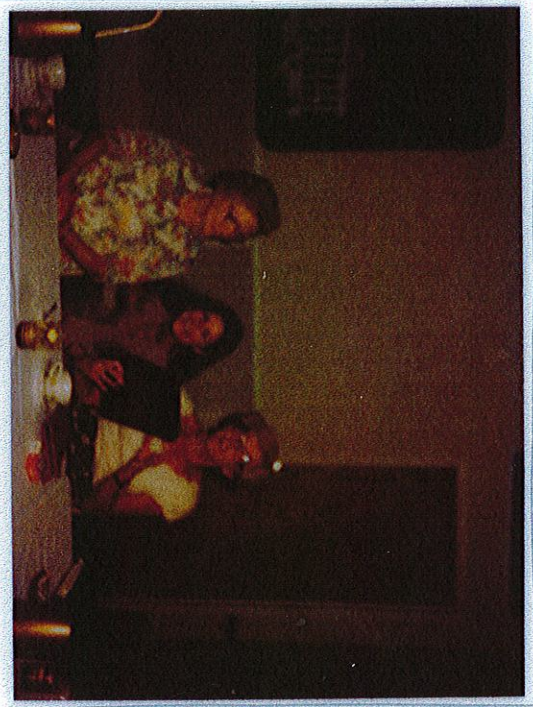

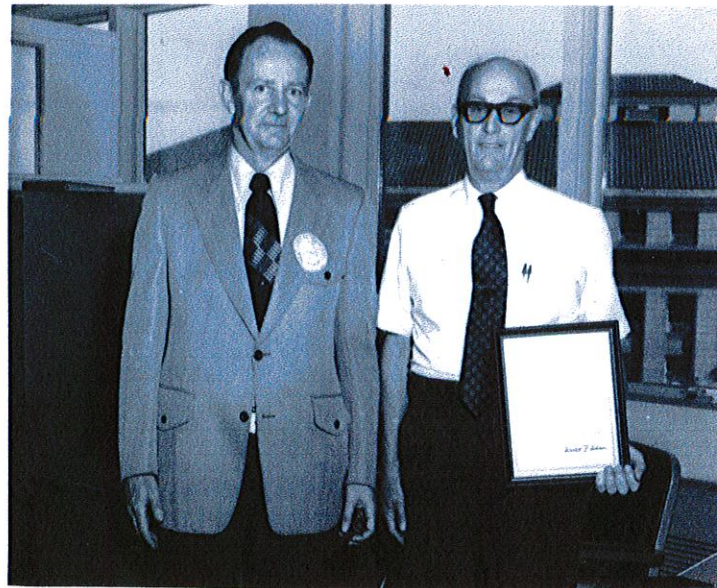
